What to Expect

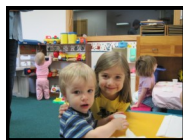
Worship—People worship in various ways. Some people sit or stand quietly to express reverence while others clap their hands, raise their arms or say “Amen” to express their love and adoration to God.



Music—A variety of hymns and contemporary songs are sung in both services with a more modern expression in the second service.

Dress—People dress in clothing styles they feel comfortable wearing including jeans, slacks, golf shirts, jackets, ties and dresses.

A well staffed **Nursery** is provided for infants and toddlers.



An **offering** is taken during the services, but it is not expected of guests to give unless they feel led to do so.

Communion is offered four times per year. Those persons who have accepted Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior are welcome to partake.
